# Kerbside Recycling

## WHAT YOU CAN RECYCLE

### Paper

- Newspapers
  - Junk mail
  - Magazines Refill paper / Office paper
- ✓ Clean dry paper only  
✓ Paper can be tied in a bundle or placed in a supermarket bag

### Cardboard

- Corrugated only
- Flatten all boxes

### Glass

- Beer bottles
  - Wine bottles
  - Spirit bottles Food bottles and jars
  - Other jars
- ✓ Remove tops and labels (where possible)  
✓ Rinse out to avoid unpleasant smells  
✓ Place different colours into separate bags

### Metal

- Aluminium cans, trays and foil
  - Beer cans
  - Food tins
  - Pet food cans
  - Aerosols
- ✓ Please clean food cans and others that smell  
✓ Flatten if possible  
✓ Place in a bag or box

### Plastic

- All drink bottles 
  - All milk bottles 
  - Any other bottles   
Including
    - Cleaning product bottles
    - Dishwashing bottles
    - Shampoo and detergent bottles
  - Bread and Supermarket bags
- ✓ Please remove tops, rinse and flatten bottles  
✓ Recycle only clean bags  
✓ Place plastic types in separate bags

**Any material NOT on the list is not recyclable**

**To reduce smells, please rinse containers**
